

Coronavirus restrictions from 1 September 2021

1 Sunday Services

There are usually less than 70 people in a building designed to seat 240.
Households may sit together. Please sit 6 feet from people who are not in your household.
To increase ventilation the choir door will be opened at the 10.00

2 Please wear a face mask if you sit in the right hand aisle

So that everyone sitting in that aisle knows that they are as safe as possible

3 Communion will be served in one kind (bread) only

There is a one way system. Please come to the front down the main aisle
Whoever is presiding will stand in the middle at the front.
Please put out your hands and you will be given a wafer with no words
Please return to the back down **BOTH** the side aisles

4 The 10.00am service will be recorded

Only the preacher and leader, the readers and intercessor will all appear on the internet
AND the congregation will not appear on the internet even when you come to communion!
The service will be uploaded to YouTube and Facebook at 12.00noon

5 Baptism, Weddings and Funerals

We are allowed up to 180 people in church
But please wear a facemask
Because some people may have come from areas with higher infection rates.
